DESCRIPTION OF POSITION

As a camp lifeguard you will be critical to the success of the summer with the responsibility of supervising campers and staff in camps aquatic. In this role you will supervise and guide campers through progressive learning experiences and water based program activities. Camp lifeguards oversee all pool maintenance and programming including lessons and other programming to engage campers and foster a passion for the water. Lifeguards will attend training with all other camp staff and will be engaging in camp groups and activities even when the pool is closed due to inclement weather.

PRIMARY DUTIES

- Maintains watchfulness over pools to prevent dangerous situations.
- Monitors and assists swimmers.
- Enforces all pool and facility rules; follows all safety-related procedures.
- Provides basic first aid.
- Performs rescue if appropriate, calls for help, provides emergency care, interviews witnesses, and files reports.
- Maintains a high level of expertise and professionalism.
- Maintains proper attire; reports with provided shirt, whistle.
- Performs basic water testing maintenance in and around pools.
- Assures pool is vacuumed, skimmed, and scrubbed daily.
- Other responsibilities as requested by supervisor.
- Attends regular in-service trainings.

- A fun loving, enthusiastic personality;
- A tremendous work ethic;
- Confidence and positive presence in both group and one-on-one settings;
- A personality and character that exudes leadership, flexibility, trustworthiness, creativity, energy, inspiration and positivity.
- A strong desire to lead by example.

- Water Safety Instructor strongly preferred
- Must be able to pass swim test as performed by Program Manager.
